



- Then we can consider how to use what we have, and how to get information we don't have.


Bureau of Labor Statistics: Librarians per capita & Library Technicians per capita






- For every 1,000 people employed in Vermont, the BLS estimates that 2.23 are librarians or media specialists, 1.15 are library technicians or clerks.
 - Vermont has the highest number of librarians and media specialists per capita
 - The number of library technicians and clerks in Vermont matches the national average.

Notes on "Librarians per capita":

- The Bureau of Labor Statistics estimates includes those in VT with the job title is "librarian"
- In general, rural states seem to be well represented. Alaska, Louisiana, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island are the next four highest states.




Notes on "Library Technicians per capita":

This graphic shows the numbers for Library Technicians, but the map for library clerical assistants is almost identical.


- In Vermont there are 0.53 are library technicians per capita
- In Vermont there are 0.62 are library clerical assistants per capita

Bureau of Labor Statistics: Annual Mean Wage of Librarians




Annual mean wage of:

- Clerical Assistants \$34,023 (just below national average)






• FTEs of school librarians and school library support staff statewide



2019 IMLS Public Library Survey

- Vermont ranks ninth in total paid staff hours per capita, with 16.33 FTE per 25,000 people. Ohio is first with 20.58, while Georgia is lowest with 6.34.
- Vermont ranks 45th in the percentage of total librarian hours with an MLS/MLIS, with 31%. Georgia is highest with 100%, and Mississippi is lowest with \$18.10. Note that there is considerable variation on the definition of a librarian between states and libraries.


- This chart combines two distinct data points from the Dept. of Libraries Public Library Annual Report over time







Median data for four sizes by population, comparing library revenue and total staff hours.




Municipal and incorporated libraries at various sizes, showing total revenue and total staff hours.







Library revenue compared with staff hours







Population compared with staff hours







Population compared with library open hours












- Shows staff hours compared with annual visits; the left is a detail focused on the majority of libraries.
- The trend lines are a general approximation.







- Shows staff hours compared with circulation; the left is a detail focused on the majority of libraries.
